#### **05/51 Chairman's opening remarks**

The Chairman welcomed all to the meeting.

#### **05/52 Apologies for Absence**

#### **05/53 Minutes**

The Minutes of the meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> October 2005 were confirmed and signed, by the Chairman, as a true record.

a) Walcott and others within the Parish

The Clerk informed the meeting that he had again contacted John Stevens (Borough Officer) and had been informed that the matter had to go to a Borough Committee for approval.

#### **05/56 Parish Improvements**

##### **Finger Posts**

The Clerk reported that he and the parish handyman had surveyed the relevant signs and a schedule was presented to Council. The required finials were: The Avenue Wrockwardine, The Green Wrockwardine, Wrekin Course, and Burcott Wrockwardine. It was resolved to purchase four finials and that the "sub area" should be worded at the top with the main area (Wrockwardine) below.

It was resolved to replace the sign at the green Wrockwardine in its entirety.

##### **Benches**

Cllr. Ballantyne outlined for the benefit of Cllr. Rawlings the resolve of Council to enhance Longyard Meadow.

It was RESOLVED to order two more benches to be sited at Bean Hill Brook and on Bratton Road adjacent to the footpath.

**Street Signs**

The Clerk presented the meeting with a suggested design and quote. Members RESOLVED to opt for the larger of the two options presented but asked the clerk to obtain examples of the sign in the colour scheme green with white lettering.

Cllr. Ballantyne asked the Clerk to request that the Borough acknowledge the Parish contribution towards the enhancement of the finger posts and to negotiate the cost under the partnership of 2:1. If the Borough is unable to contribute financially to the scheme then perhaps they would give us credit elsewhere.

The Clerk passed the bank mandate to members for their signature.

**05/58 Next Meeting**

The Clerk was asked to request that the Borough top up the parish grit bins in readiness for winter.
